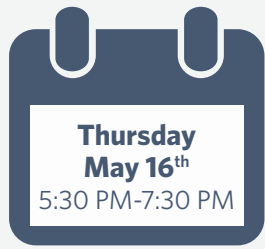

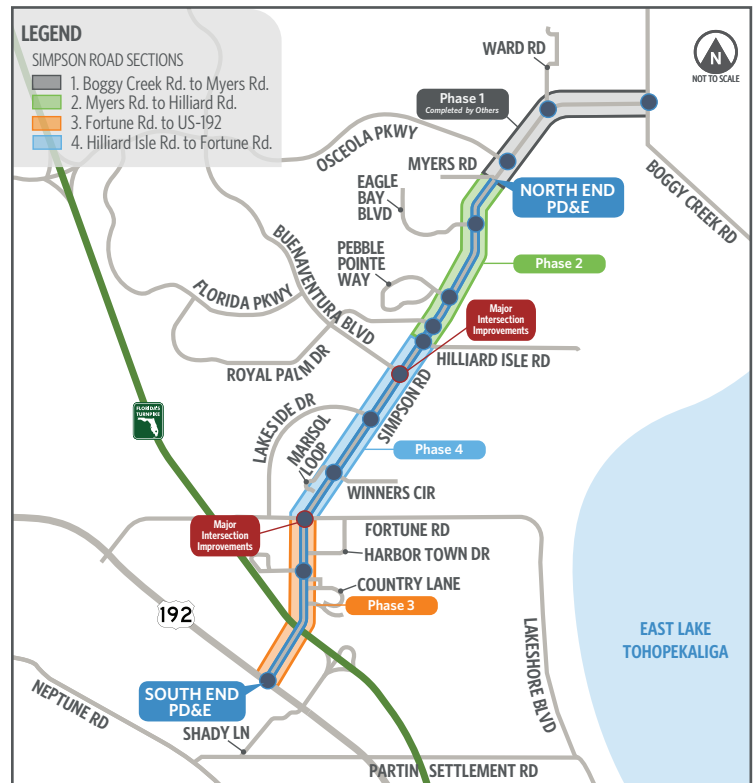
i SIMPSON ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Osceola County is evaluating improving Simpson Road, from US Highway 192 to 560' south of Myers Road. This study is evaluating many possible improvements including additional corridor capacity such as **roadway widening, bicycle lanes or multi-use paths, and completed sidewalk networks.** Public involvement is encouraged and the first, in-person opportunity to provide feedback is an alternatives public meeting on May 16th.

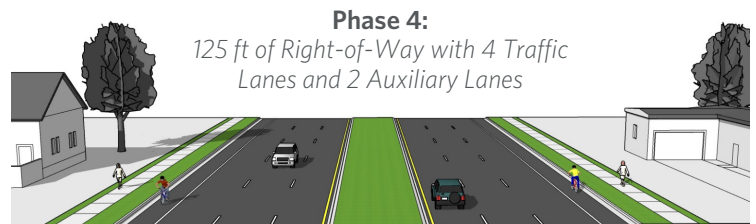
🛣️ SIMPSON ROAD: US HIGHWAY 192 TO MYERS ROAD

TYPICAL SECTION A: ON-STREET BIKE LANE



Phase 2 & 3:
115 ft of Right-of-Way with 4 Traffic Lanes



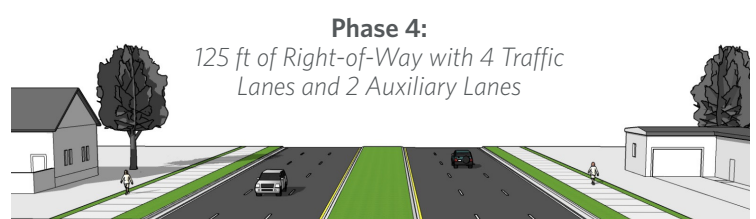
Phase 4:
125 ft of Right-of-Way with 4 Traffic Lanes and 2 Auxiliary Lanes

This option provides traffic lanes in each direction with separation of bicycle users and pedestrians.

TYPICAL SECTION B: SHARED USE PATH



Phase 2 & 3:
115 ft of Right-of-Way with 4 Traffic Lanes



Phase 4:
125 ft of Right-of-Way with 4 Traffic Lanes and 2 Auxiliary Lanes

This option provides traffic lanes in each direction with bicycle users and pedestrians sharing a multi-use path.
